Ezekiel 9-10 – the Glory disappeared until the incarnation at Bethlehem, possibly the star was the Shekinah glory.

- I. Three Groups
 - a. Politicians Abhorred (Herod Matthew 2:3, 16)

Christ would interfere with his right to rule

b. **Religious** Ignored (Scribes, Pharisees - Matthew 2:4)

Hosea 11:1

Knew Content, not Christ

Lack love & obedience (John 7:17)

c. Magi Adored (Daniel 5:11, Matthew 1:1-2, 7-11)

O Come let us adore Him, Christ the Lord!

Daniel saved the hides of the other Magi

Knowledgeable academically and spiritually in tune

- II. Three Gifts (Matthew 2:11)
 - a. Gold for **Royalty**
 - i. Mighty **King** (Daniel 4:34-37)
 - b. Frankincense for **Deity**
 - i. Ministering **Priest** (Hebrews 4:15-5:1)
 - c. Myrrh for **Humanity**
 - i. Martyred **Prophet** (II Corinthians 5:21)
 - ii. The Just One, the perfect Man
- III. Three Words (Luke 1:8-14)
 - a. **Joy** (Luke 2:10)
 - i. Holy Happiness (Psalm 16:11, John 15:11, John 16:24, John 17:13)
 - b. **Peace** (Luke 2:14)
 - i. Holy Oneness (Romans 5:9-11, Philippians 4:4)
 - ii. Were enemies, reconciled to be sons (Romans 5:8-10)
 - iii. Propitiation satisfied the wrath, the just demand of a holy God

- iv. Replace anxiousness with Peace (Philippians 4:6-7)
- v. Peace given from Jesus (John 14:27)
- c. **Glory** (Luke 2:14)
 - i. Holy Purpose
 - ii. Departure (Ezekiel 8) from temple
 - iii. Now (1 Corinthians 6:15-20) indwelling the believer
